



RULES FOR MARAE REWANA BAKE OFF

1. Bread must be made with a bug
2. Representation must be registered.
3. To register the Marae chairperson must text Kaylee Ngarimu on 0274-604-105 or email Kaylee at kayleengarimu@gmail.com I will message you a confirmation reply.
4. Only one entry per Marae.
5. All entries must be brought to the kaumatua tent at Anzac park between 10-10.30am on the 6th February 2015.
6. On arrival you will be given a number so nobody including the judges know who cooked the rewana. Only I will hold the details about who made the bread and what marae they affiliate too.
7. After the winner has been announced the rewana bread remains the property of the event organizers to distribute amongst the crowd.
8. If you wish to include a person/s who do not affiliate to your Marae by either whakapapa or marriage then you **MUST** ensure that your Marae committee endorses and approves their inclusion in the bake off.

9. Participants may only **register** under and **compete** for one Marae.
10. If your team wishes to contest any decision made, you will be required to lodge an official complaint to the event co-ordinator (Kaylee Ngarimu) within 10 minutes of the winner being announced. The issue will then be adjudicated by an independent panel, within 30 minutes of the issue being lodged. The decision of the adjudicating panel is final and no discussion will be entered into.

1. Shape and form of the Rewana bread
2. Texture (light and airier)
3. Moisture (amount of water evaporation)
4. The ratio of crust to crumb
