- Flu jabs for pakeke and those with chronic conditions.
- Flu jabs for frontline Hauora and welfare kaimahi
- COVID-19 testing via Healthline & GP referral
- Promote health and safety practices, individual, household, marae

## Iwi-led (Winter) Heating Response

- Firewood depots and distribution channels across our rohe.
- Warm clothing and blanket packs and distribution channels
- Other.

## Iwi-led Help Response

- Funding for immediate help placed with identified local action groups
- Hygiene and kai packs for assembly and distribution.
- Partnering with MSD and other relief agencies to promote, target and deliver welfare support to our priority groups.

## Iwi-led Harm free Response

- Whangaia (Family Harm Incident and prevention) Team.
- Tele and online mental health & relationship services
- Supporting whanau with vulnerable tamariki known to our services
- Sharing whanau experiences and 'lock down tips'
